It was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the Burgess is hereby authorized to procure the necessary equipment for the Borough police officer.

Upon motion, which was seconded it was unanimously RESOLVED that the rate of compensation for the Borough Police Officer be Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour plus car milage of Ten Cents per mile.

At this time President Townsend declared a recess until after the public hearing on the request of Mr. & Mrs. Kerns for a change of Zoning.

The meeting was again called to order by President Townsend at 8.30 P. M. Since there were no objections or protests registered against the request of Mr. & Mrs. Kerns Sr. it was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the request of Mr. & Mrs Kerns for a change of zoning from R2

District to B District is hereby granted.
