

MINUTES OF THE 147th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE CHESTER HEIGHTS FIREHOUSE MONDAY APRIL 6th 1959 at 8.00 P. M.

The Treasurers Report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

At this time Mr. Pottash of the Mid-States Equip. Company requested reconsideration of his application to erect a large electric sign for the Texas Company on the property of Irwin Little. As this application was denied at the January meeting, no further action was taken at this time.

Burgess Breneman administered the Oath of Office to Mr. Lewis Baker as part time Police Officer for the Borough.

Mr. Walter Schrader turned in all police equipment which was placed in his custody when the former Police Force was discontinued.

Mr. Jobson presented Ordinance #38 to create a Dept. of Borough Planning which shall be in charge of a Borough Planning Commission consisting of five members to be appointed by Council. Since it is the intention of Council to adopt this Ordinance at the May meeting, it was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the Sect'y., is directed to advertise this Ordinance in accordance with the regulations of the Borough Code.
