

MINUTES OF THE 148th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE CHESTER HEIGHTS FIREHOUSE MONDAY MAY 4th 1959 at 8.00 P. M.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by President Townsend. The members absent were Mr. Hobough, Mr. Kerns and Mr, Wood.

The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurers report as presented by Miss Dickson was approved. Burgess Report; Mr. Breneman^{reported} on a violation of Sections 408.5 and 408.8 of the Zoning Ordinance by O'Connell's Service Station where a sign was placed across a public highway. Mr. O'Connell was notified to remove the sign within 24 hours. As the sign was not removed at the expiration of 24 hours, Mr. O'Connell was summoned before Justice of Peace Mathues and a fine of Twenty-five Dollars imposed.

Mr. Breneman also reported that he had advised the new tenant of part of the Groff property to appeal th the Zoning Board of Adjustment for a special exception.

Unfinished business; Ordinance #38 creating a Borough Planning Commission was read by President Townsend. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this ordinance is hereby adopted.

New business; A petition from Misses Margaret and Frances Groff requesting a reclassification of their property from Residential to Business District was presented to Council. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that a Public Hearing be held on June 1st. at 7.30 P. M. in the Fire House to consider this petition.

Penna. Dept. of Highways plans covering proposed construction work on Route #1 and Resolutions covering estimated property damages of \$73,669.00 were submitted to Council. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously agreed that the Borough of Chester Heights is not financially able to assume these property damages, therefore these Resolutions are not approved and the Secretary directed to so advise the Penna. Dept. of Highways.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
