

MINUTES OF THE 156th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY JAN. 4th 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

Certificates of Election were presented by Mr. Samuel Jobson, Mr. C. N. Smitheman, Jr. and Mr. Samuel Ward, Jr., and the Oath of Office as members of Council was then administered by Burgess Breneman.

With all members present, the meeting was called to order by President Townsend.

The Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved.
