

MINUTES OF THE 157th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY FEBRUARY 1st 1960

This meeting was called to order by President Townsend at 8.10 P. M.

with all members present excepting Mr. Jobson And Mr. Wood.
Mr. John F. Cramp, the Boro. Solicitor was also present.

Burgess report;

Mr. Breneman reported that the No-parking regulations would be enforced on Valleybrook Road and requested clarification of the regulations governing parking throughout the Borough in accordance with Ordinance #21. This was referred to the Committee on Public Safety.

Building Inspector Report;

Mr. Voigt requested that consideration be given for the adoption of an Ordinance regulating the erection of advertising signs within the Borough.

This was referred to the Planning Commission for recommendations.

Unfinished business;

Ordinance #40, establishing rules and regulations governing the sub-division of land within the Borough of Chester Heights, was presented for final consideration. It was then moved, and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that Ordinance #40, as presented, is hereby adopted.

New Business;

Considerable discussion was held on the recent installation of newspaper containers on numerous properties

within the Borough. Miss Dickson advised that the Planning Commission was of the opinion that these containers do not conform with the provisions of the Borough Zoning Ordinance. Mr. Hobough volunteered to interview the person responsible for these containers.

Mr. Hobough presented the proposed Budget for the year 1960. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved, that the 1960 Budget as presented, is hereby adopted.

The next order of business was the fixing of the tax rate for the year 1960. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that Ordinance #41, fixing the Tax Rate for the year 1960 for General Borough purposed in the sum of Eight and one-half ($8\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation on all property in the Borough subject to taxation, is hereby adopted.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
