

MINUTES OF THE 159th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY APRIL 4TH 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by President Townsend. The absentee members were Mr. Hobough, Mr. Kerns and Mr. Wood.

The minutes of the March meeting were read and approved.

At this time President Townsend called upon Mr. Edwin F. Deegan and his attorney Mr. F. J. Lynch, who presented the agreement between Hedgewood Inc., and the Borough of Chester Heights, for the sub-division of the former Willcox property west of Valleybrook Rd. at Wawa Road. This agreement has been approved by the Borough Solicitor. It was then moved by Mr. Ward and seconded by Mr. Jobson and unanimously RESOLVED, that since the application for this sub-division was presented prior to the adoption of the Borough Sub-Division Ordinance and that all of the pertinent provisions of the Sub-Division Ordinance have been incorporated into this agreement and the roadways are officially designated as Mildred Lane and Wawa Road respectfully, therefore President Townsend is hereby authorized to sign this agreement on behalf of Borough Council.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Mr. Ward advised that the revised Building & Plumbing Code has been approved by the Borough Solicitor and that copies have been distributed to members of Council for study.

Mr. Townsend advised that he has communicated with Mr. Baker and that he would accept the position of Borough Engineer. It was then moved

and seconded and unanimously approved that Mr. Chester Baker is hereby engaged as Borough Engineer at an annual retainer fee not to exceed Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

Further discussion was held on the problem of parking on the Borough roads. This was then referred to the Committee of Public Safety with a request to report back at the May meeting. There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
