

MINUTES OF THE 161st MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS  
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY JUNE 6th 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend, with all members present.

The minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

Burgess report; Mr. Breneman rendered his report on the enforcement of Borough Ordinances during the month and suggested the replacement of one "No-Parking" sign on Valleybrook Road.

The Building Code Committee advised that the minor changes suggested by the Boro. Engineer have been considered and that the new Code is now complete.

Unfinished business; The question of the Ordinance covering the re-zoning of the Groff property was discussed and Mr. Townsend agreeded to contact the Borough Solicitor regarding this Ordinance. The Public Safety Committee advised they would meet and consider Firearms regulations and report at the next meeting.

The Secretary was directed to write the Borough Planning Committee requesting a re-study of Borough Ordinance #6 and to submit their recommendations for penalties and the erection of appropriate signs for the control of littering on the Borough Roads.

New Business; Mr. Ward presented the revised Building and Plumbing Code. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved

that the Secretary is hereby authorized to advertise the intention of Borough Council to adopt at the regular meeting to be held on July 11th 1960, Ordinance #A+2 known as the "Building and Sanitation Code, Borough of Chester Heights.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
