

MINUTES OF THE 164th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY SEPT. 12th 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend with all members present excepting Mr. Hobough and Mr. Jobson.

The minutes of the August meeting were read and approved.

The resignation of Mr. Samuel Jobson as a member of Council was read and accepted.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Burgess Report; Mr. Breneman advised that Lewis Baker has resigned as part time Police Officer. Mr. Breneman also recommended that the shoulder of the roadway along the property of the School Board on Valleybrook Road opposite the Groff property be widened to allow sufficient parking space at this location. This was referred to the Highway Committee to obtain permission from the School Board and to obtain bids for the cost of the work.

Public Safety Committee Report; It was recommended that John Rapp and John Voigt be appointed as part-time Police Officers for the Borough. It was so moved and seconded and unanimously approved.

New Business; Mr. Wood advised that Mrs. ^{Thompson}Schroeder has granted permission to the Borough to cut back the shrubbery along the fence of her property at the intersection of Wawa and Valleybrook Roads. In view of the safety factor involved it is the opinion of members of Council that the Borough should assume the cost of

clearing this intersection.
