

MINUTES OF THE 165th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY OCTOBER 3rd 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

This meeting was called to order by President Townsend with all members and the Burgess present.

The Minutes of the September meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

BURGESS REPORT: Mr. Breneman advised that the two part-time Police Officers were now on intermittent patrol duty throughout the Borough and that plans have been prepared to place extra deputies on duty during the Hollow'een season.

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE REPORT: Mr. Hobough advised he had obtained a bid from Anthony Felice in the amount of \$175.00 to repair the surface of Mattson Road. Due to the small amount involved, no other bids were obtainable. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this bid is hereby accepted.

Public Safety Committee recommended that Ordinance #21 be ammended to raise the parking fine in Sec. #15 from One Dollar to Two Dollars and that the Public Safety Committee be designated to administer this Ordinance instead of the Police Committee.

Mr. Kerns presented a proposed Ordinance to prohibit the use of all hunting rifles above .22 calibre within the Borough. The Secretary was directed to advertise the intention of Council to adopt this Ordinance at the November meeting.

Public Safety Committee also advised that commencing Nov. 15th. all parking on Valleybrook Road would be prohibited. The Secretary was directed to notify Mr. Geo. Wilson of this change.

Planning Commission Report; Miss Dickson advised that the Commission had met and were currently considering anti-littering regulations for the Borough, and also an up-to date Borough map.

Unfinished business; The name of Mr. Stephen S. Gardner was presented as a candidate to fill the vacancy on Council, which was caused by the resignation of Mr. Jobson. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that Mr. Gardner is hereby appointed a member of Borough Council to serve the unexpired term of Mr. Samuel Jobson. This term expires on the first Monday of January 1964.

Mr. Townsend advised that the Borough Solicitor has been requested to prepare an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance changing the classification of the Groff property from residential to business.

Mr. John McManus presented a deed of dedication for the roadway in the Wawa Hills development in accordance with his previous agreement. This deed is to be forwarded to the Solicitor for approval and recommendations.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
