 HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY NOVEMBER 7th 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

The Burgess reported on Police activities for the month of October.

Highway Committee-

Mr. Hobough advised that the repairs to Mattson have been completed in a satisfactory manner and that arrangements have been made for the removal of the shrubbery at the intersection of Valleybrook and Wawa Roads. Mr. Hobough also advised that arrangements have been completed for cindering Borough Roads and presented a bid from Lewis Baker to furnish one truck and driver at the rate of \$4.50 per hour and a helper at the rate of \$2.50 per hour when called upon to spread the cinders, which will be furnished by the State Highway Dept.

It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this bid is hereby accepted.

Planning Commission Report;

Miss Dickson advised that a meeting of the Commission was held and further considerations were given on Anti-littering regulations and a new Borough map. Also that the Dela. County Planning Commission has proposed a re-study of the Borough land use regulations at a cost to the Borough of \$200.00 This project is highly recommended by the Borough Planning Commission. It was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that the Delaware County Planning Commission is hereby authorized to schedule and proceed with a planning re-study of the Borough of Chester Heights at a cost of \$200.00.

Unfinished business;

Mr. Kerns presented Ordinance #A+2, which prohibits the use of high powered rifles within the Borough. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this Ordinance is hereby adopted.

Mr. Townsend presented Ordinance #A+3, changing the Zoning clasification of the Groff property from R-2 to B-business. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this Ordinance is hereby adopted.

New business; Burgess Ereneman advised he has received several complaints regarding magazine solicitors and recommended that Council consider regulations to control this type of business. There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
