

MINUTES OF THE 167th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOR. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
 HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY DEC. 5th 1960 at 8.00 P. M.

With President Townsend presiding, the meeting was called to order with the Burgess and all members present excepting Mr. Smitheman.

The minutes of the Nov. meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

Communication from Citizens Council of Dela. Co., with questionnaire enclosed, regarding the Dela. County proposed open space conservation and recreation program was read and referred to the Boro. Planning Commission for further handling.

Communication from Chester Heights Fire Co. requesting execution of attached Resolution concerning Insurance coverage on activities beyond the Borough limits, was read and ordered tabled pending clarification by Insurance broker.

Communication from Mr. John Hamilton offering services as Dog Catcher was ordered acknowledged and filed.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Planning Commission report;

Miss Dickson advised that due to the death of Mr. Willcox

a meeting of the Commission was not called, however Miss Dickson presented the names of three prospective candidates suggested by the remaining members of the Commission to serve the unexpired term of Mr. Willcox. They are Mr. Edwin Keller, Mr. John McManus and Mr. James Ross. They have all agreed to serve should they be appointed.

Upon motion by Mr. Townsend, which was duly seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED that the Secretary is hereby directed to write to Mrs. Willcox expressing the sympathy of all members of Council on the death of Mr. J. Taney Willcox on Nov. 16th.

Mr. Willcox served as the first President of Borough Council, from January 1946 to December 1951 and at the time of his death was Chairman of the Borough Planning Commission.

Burgess report; Mr. Breneman advised that the No-Parking regulation recently put into effect on Valleybrook Road has proven successful, also that residents on Llewelyn Road have requested that a speed limit of 35 MPH be placed on this road and the installation of No-Parking signs at the turn in the road which has been the scene of several accidents. This was referred to the Committee of Public Safety.

At this time President Townsend appointed Mr. Gardner a member of the Public Safety Committee and designated Mr. Kerns as Chairman of this committee.

Building Inspector Report; Mr. Voigt advised that eighteen Building permits have been issued to the "Old Ivy" developers to date.

Building Code Committee; Mr. Ward advised that he is in possession of several copies of the new Code which are being edited and will be returned to the printer for final printing.

New Business;

President Townsend called for nominations of candidates to fill the vacancy on the Borough Planning Commission created by the death of Mr. Willcox. Mr. Edwin Keller, Mr. Jas. Ross and Mr. John McManus were duly nominated. Nominations were then declared closed and balloting proceeded, with the result that Mr. Jas. C. Ross, Jr. received the majority vote and was thereby appointed to serve the unexpired term of Mr. J. Taney Willcox on the Borough Planning Commission. This term expires on May 31st 1961.

Ordinance No. 6 as amended, prohibiting dumping, littering and stream pollution within the limits of the Borough of Chester Heights, and ^{providing} a maximum penalty of One hundred Dollars for violations thereof, was presented for approval. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that this Ordinance is hereby adopted.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
