

MINUTES OF THE 169th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY FEBRUARY 6th 1961 at 8.00 P. M.

It was then moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that the Budget for the year 1961 as presented is hereby adopted and that the Tax rate for General Borough purposes shall be the sum of Eight and one-half ($8\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.
