

MINUTES OF THE 180th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE TUESDAY JANUARY 2nd 1962 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend with all members present. Justice of Peace T. O. Buckley administered the oath of Office to Clifford T. Farr, John D. Kelly, Lohr E. Kerns, Jr., and Edwin B. Hobaugh as members of Council and to Earl Sharp and Thomas Dietz , Auditors, and H. Herbert Breneman, Mayor.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Mr. Hobough also appointed the Budget Committee composed of Mr. Gardner, Chairman, Mr. Ward, Mr. Kerns and Mr. Smitheman to prepare the 1962 Budget for presentation at the February meeting.
