It is regretfully noted that Mrs. Marie T. Jobson passed away on May 6th 1962. Mrs. Jobson has served as Borough Tax Collector since Feb. 1955.

Miss Anna Dickson was unanimously appointed to serve as tempory
Tax Collector. President Hobaugh appointed a committee composed
of Mr. Gardner, Mr. Smitheman and Mr. Ward to recommend a candidate
to serve the unexpired term of Mrs. Jobson as Tax Collector.
It was unanimously approved that the sum of Three Hundred Dollars
be paid to the Chester Heights Fire Co. at this time.
