

MINUTES OF THE 184th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS  
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY MAY 7th 1962 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Hobough, with all members and the Mayor present.

The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

At this time the usual order of business was interrupted to allow Mr. Deegan and his attorney to be heard. Mr. Deegan advised that he would like to arrange for the dedication of the roadways of the Old Ivy development to the Borough. Mr. Deegan was informed that the Borough would not accept the roadways until the agreement between the Borough and the developer was fully complied with. Therefore the Highway Committee, with Mr. Ward cooperating, was directed to arrange to meet with Mr. Deegan and the Borough Engineer to discuss the corrections to be made before dedication would be considered. Mayor Breneman reported that he had informed Mr. Deegan that the signs at the entrance to the Old Ivy development on Wawa Road must be removed by May 15th.

Upon the recommendation of the committee appointed to propose a candidate for the vacancy on the Borough Planning Commission, it was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that Mr. John J. Kelly is hereby appointed for a five year term commencing June 1st 1962.

It is regretfully noted that Mrs. Marie T. Jobson passed away on May 6th 1962. Mrs. Jobson has served as Borough Tax Collector since Feb. 1955.

Miss Anna Dickson was unanimously appointed to serve as temporary Tax Collector. President Hobough appointed a committee composed of Mr. Gardner, Mr. Smitheman and Mr. Ward to recommend a candidate to serve the unexpired term of Mrs. Jobson as Tax Collector.

It was unanimously approved that the sum of Three Hundred Dollars be paid to the Chester Heights Fire Co. at this time.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Borough Council desires to limit the speed on State Highway Appl. 6254 in the Borough Chester Height in the county of Delaware, between Sta. 30+87 left side and Sta. 38+31 right side and Sta. 66+47 both sides and

WHEREAS, Signs will be required in accordance with the provisions of The Vehicle Code and the Manual of Regulations for Official Traffic Signs and Signals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the speed on State Highways Appl. 6254 from Sta. 30+87 left side to Sta. 38+31 right side shall be and is hereby limited to 40 miles per hour, and from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ shall be, and is hereby limited to \_\_\_\_\_ miles per hour, after proper signs have been erected, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Borough Council of Chester Heights Borough does hereby request the Department of Highways to authorize the erection of signs on said State Highway Route in accordance with The Vehicle Code, and the Manual of Regulations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That speed on said State Highway shall not be restricted unless or until the Secretary of Highways approves this resolution and authorizes the erection of the necessary signs as above.
