

MINUTES OF THE 185th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS

Highway Committee reported that a meeting was held with the Boro, Engineer regarding the roadways in the Old Ivy development and a later meeting has been scheduled with Mr. Deegan.

Unfinished business. Mr. Smitheman, reporting for the committee appointed for the purpose of selecting candidates for the office of Borough Tax Collector, recommended Miss Anna Dickson, Mrs. Josephine Breneman and Hilton Jones, who were then duly nominated. Ballots were distributed to members of Council and President Hobaugh appointed Mr. Robert Sparkman to tally the ballots, with the result that Mrs. Breneman was elected by majority vote. Therefore it was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that Mrs. H. Herbert Breneman is hereby appointed Tax Collector for the Borough of Chester Heights, to serve the

unexpired term of Mrs. Marie T. Jobson, deceased.

New Business. Mr. Gardner advised that he has received a communication from Mr. Edwin Keller, Civil Defense Director, with the recommendation that the local Civil Defense organization be disbanded.
