

MINUTES OF THE 187th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY AUGUST 6th 1962 at 8.00,P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Hobaugh, with all members present except Mr. Kerns.

The minutes of the July meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurers report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Mayor Breneman reported on Police activities during the month of July and suggested the use of a portable scale as a possible solution to the control of over-weigh trucks and also recommended the installation of flashing warning signals on Valleybrook Road in the vicinity of St. Thomas School. Mr. Breneman also reported further progress with the Highway Dept. on his negotiations for the repairs to the PRR bridge. Mr. Breneman presented a letter from the Dela. County Chamber of Commerce requesting information on any available land that could be used for light industry such as research and development. This was referred to the Boro. Planning Commission for further consideration. Highway Committee Report; This committee advised that the approximate cost for the purchase and installation of the speed limit signs on Llewelyn Road would be \$150.00. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this committee is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary signs.

New Business; Mr. Hobaugh expressed his disapproval of the unsightly condition of the road sides and banks of our highways which was

caused by the use of weed killing spray by the State Highway Dept. After considerable discussion, Mr. Breneman agreed to investigate and try to determine why this was done without consulting the Borough Authorities.

It was unanimously agreed that the next meeting of Council will be held on Tuesday Sept. 4th. due to the Labor Day holiday. There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
