

MINUTES OF THE 188th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO FIREHOUSE TUESDAY SEPT. 4th 1962 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Hobough, with the Mayor and all members present excepting Mr. Ward.

A large number of Borough residents were also present.

The minutes of the August meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

At this time the usual order of business was interrupted to hear from the delegation of citizens who were present. Mrs. John D. Kelly, acting as spokesman for the group, protested against speeding on Valleybrook Road and requested further regulations and protection be provided during school hours. After a lengthy discussion this was referred to the Committee of Public Safety, who was authorized to purchase and install 15 mile per hour signs in the vicinity of the Borough schools and to consider the employment of an additional part time policeman during school hours.

Building Inspector John Voigt declared that there were no provisions in the Building Code covering Certificates of Occupancy on rental properties. This was referred to the Ordinance Committee. Miss Dickson advised that the Planning Commission had met and that several matters were under consideration and that a more complete report would be rendered at a later date.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
