

MINUTES OF THE 190th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY NOVEMBER 5th 1962 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Ward, with all members present excepting President Hobaugh and Mr. Smitheman.

The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved.

Report of Mayor; Mr. Breneman withdrew his resignation, which had been presented at the October meeting. Mr. Breneman advised that he has been unsuccessful in his attempts on the rebuilding or repairing of the PRR bridge, therefore is considering the matter closed at this time. Mr. Breneman also advised that the Halloween Patrol was again successful this year, with no mischief reported, and extended a vote of thanks to everyone who took part in this operation.

Highway Report; Mr. Kerns reported highway signs repaired and repainted, and cinders will be obtained for use on Boro. roads during the winter.

No progress reported on the repairs to the roadways of the Old Ivy development in accordance with the agreement, therefore it was moved and seconded and un^{an}animously approved that the Boro. solicitor is authorized to proceed with legal action against Hedgewood Inc.

Unfinished business; Mr. Gardner recommended that an Ordinance covering certificates of occupancy on rental properties not be enacted as such an ordinance is not required at this time.

Mr. Gardner advised that Mr. Edwin Keller is very anxious to relinquish the post of Civil Defense Director for the Boro. This was referred to the Committee of Public Safety to recommend a replacement for Mr. Keller. In the meantime, in order to comply with the request of the State Council of Civil Defense, it was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that Mr. Keller is hereby designated Shelter Official for the Borough of Chester Heights, charged with the responsibility for the coordination of all county, or local activities associated with the conduct of the National Fallout Shelter Survey. The Secretary was directed to execute the necessary Forms and forward to the County Director of Civil Defense.

Miss Dickson presented the Treasurer's report, which was approved. New Business; Mayor Breneman recommended that a larger street light should be installed at the intersection of Rt. #1 and Valleybrook Road. This was referred to the Highway Committee. Mr. Westlake of the Westlake Plastics Co. requested permission to burn trash consisting only of paper and cardboard cartons, in the rear of their property on Lenni Road. This was referred to the Boro. Fire Marshall.

After a short recess, the meeting resumed in Executive session to consider various matters of Public Safety, including the replacement of Policeman John Voigt, whose resignation has been accepted.

There being no further business, the meeting the adjourned.
