The Treasurer's report was presented and approved.

Mayor Breneman advised that he had conducted a tour of the Borough with Mr. Clemmens. of the Dela. County Chamber of Commerce, who is interested in selecting a suitable location for a proposed Research & Development Center in Dela. County.

Upon the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee, it was unanimously approved that Mr. Chas. V. Hildenbrand be engaged as a part-time Policeman for the Borough.

Mr. Kerns advised that he had contacted the Phila. Electric Co. regarding the installation of a larger street light at the intersection of Rt. #1 and Valleybrook rd. As this would require considerable additional expense to the Boro. no action was taken at this time.

Mr. Kerns also reported that as Fire Marshall for the Borough, he has inspected the property of the Westlake Plastics Co. and approved the burning of paper and cartons, under proper supervision.

President Hobaugh appointed the Budget Committee, consisting of

Mr. Gardner as Chairman, with Mr. Ward, Mr. Kerns and Mr. Smitheman,
to prepare the 1963 Budget.
