The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson and approved.

Mayor Breneman recommended that the present Fire Prevention Code be re-studied and possibly revised to current standards. This was referred to the Fire Marshall and the Safety Committee.

Miss Dickson advised that a meeting of the Planning Commission was held and that a report on the re-study of the present Zoning Ordinance was received from the Delaware County Planning Commission. The Commission requested that Borough Council define the commercial areas of the Borough to complete the re-study. This was referred to the Zoning Committee.

Unfinished business; Upon the recommendation of the Zoning Committee and the unanimous vote of Council, the application of Mr. Alan Thomas to change the zoning classification of the Thomas property from R-2 District to B District is hereby denied.

New business; Miss Dickson declared that the entrance to the Wawa Post Office is in poor and unsafe condition and inquired as to what could be done to correct this condition. This was referred to the Public Safety Committee for investigation. There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
