

MINUTES OF THE 197th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY JUNE 3rd 1963 at 8.00 P. M.

In the absence of the Treas., the Sect'y., read the Treas. Report, which was approved.

Mayor Breneman advised that John Voigt has turned in the records of Bldg. Inspector and has moved from the Borough.

A discussion was held on the prospects of obtaining a replacement for Mr. John Voigt, as Bldg. Inspector.
