A discussion was held on the possibility of acquiring the Boro. School building for Borough purposes. This building has been recently offered for sale by the School Board. It was unanimously "RESOLVED, that Council of the Borough of Chester Heights respectfully requests the Chester Heights School Directors to with-hold the proposed sale of the Chester Heights School building until the members of Council have been granted an opportunity to meet with the School Board to discuss this matter."

Mr. Hobough appointed a committee of Mr. Smitheman, chairman, Mr. Farr and Mr. Kerns to arrange a meeting with the School Board.

Mr. Smitheman presented for discussion the subject ^{of} the mandatory merger

of School Districts as proposed under Act 561 which is now before the State Legislature. The Secretary was directed to request the School Board to advise Council as to the position of the School Board regarding this proposed merger.
