The Treasurer's report was presented by Miss Dickson, And approved.

Mayor Breneman requested additional volunteers for the annual Halloween Patrol to be conducted on October 30th & 31st.

At the suggestion of the Mayor, the Secretary was directed to write the Penna. Dept. of Highways protesting the removal of a Stop sign at the intersection of Valleybrook & Bodley Rds.

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE; Mr. Kerns advised that work on Wawa Road has been completed and recommended that the Borough accept dedication of the roadways of the Old Ivy development, therefore it was unanimously approved that the Borough Solicitor is authorized to proceed with the papers of dedication.

Mr. Kerns requested authorization to purchase 4 portable radios for Civil Defense purposes, at a cost of \$160.00. This was approved. Motion was also approved to transfer \$60.00 additional to the Civil Defense Budget.
