

MINUTES OF THE 202nd MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY NOV. 4th 1963 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Ward, with the Mayor and all members present excepting Mr. Hobough and Mr. Farr.

The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was read by Miss Dickson and approved.

Mayor Breneman expressed his thanks to all persons who took part in the Halloween Patrol. There were no reports of vandalism.

A discussion was held on Mr. Breneman's suggestion that the Penna. Dept. of Highways be requested to eliminate the designation of Route #261 through the Borough. This was referred to the Highway Committee, who were directed to correspond with the Dept. of Highways.

Mr. Ward appointed a committee of Mr. Gardner, Mr. Kerns and Mr. Kelly to recommend a candidate for Borough Engineer.

This meeting was declared recessed until Monday Nov. 11th 1963 at which time consideration will be given to proposed ammendment to the Borough Zoning Ordinance.

MONDAY NOVEMBER 11th 1963 at 7.20 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Ward. The other members present were Mr. Hobough, Mr. Kelly, Mr. Kerns.

The Zoning Committee presented a proposed ammendment to the Borough Zoning Ordinance to change the designation of the Business area on Baltimore Pike.

It was then moved and seconded and unanimously "RESOLVED, that notice be given that a Public Hearing will be held by the Council of the Boro. of Chester Heights on the 2nd day of December 1963, at 7.30 P. M. in the Boro. Firehouse, to consider an ordinance to amend the Borough Zoning Map, by changing the following area of the Borough of Chester Heights from Class R2 and B to Class B., Beginning at a point in the center of Baltimore Pike at its intersection with Valleybrook Road in the center line, known as U. S. Route #1; thence extending westerly along the center line of the said Baltimore Pike to a point where the Borough line intersects with the said Baltimore Pike; thence along the Borough line in a southerly direction to a point three hundred and fifty feet; thence at right angles, more or less, along a line parallel to the said Baltimore Pike, every point along the said line being three hundred and fifty feet from the center line of the said Baltimore Pike; easterly to a point located in the center of the said Valleybrook Road at a point three hundred and fifty feet south of the center of the intersection of Baltimore Pike and Valleybrook Road; thence extending in a northerly direction three hundred and fifty feet to the point and place of beginning."

The meeting then adjourned.
