

MINUTES OF THE 205th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS  
 HELD IN THE BORO. FIREHOUSE MONDAY FEBRUARY 3rd 1964 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Ward. Members present were Mr. Gardner, Mr. Kelly, Mr. Kerns, Mr. Smitheman and Mayor Breneman.

The minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

The following receipts were reported and handed to the Treas.;

The Treasurer's report was read by Miss. Dickson and approved.

Mayor Breneman recommended that the Public Safety and Highway Committees consider the establishment of a No-Parking zone on Smithbridge Road.

Highway Committee; Further discussion was held on the drainage problem on Wawa Road. The committee recommended the appointment of J. Walter Cozzens as Boro. Engineer for the term of one year. This was unanimously approved.

Public Safety Committee; Mr. Smitheman advised that in the opinion of this committee, a revision of the present Firearms Ordinance is not required at this time.

Mr. Jas. Ross was unanimously appointed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment, to replace Dr. Geo. Stark and Mr. Lundquist was re-appointed for a term of three years.

Mr. Gardner reported receipt of notification from the School Board advising that an offer of \$13,000.00 for the school building has been received. The Secretary was directed to advise the School Board that Borough Council has decided not to purchase the building for Boro. purposes and that the members of Council feel that the School Board should have offered the building to the Borough for a nominal sum, in order that the property could be held for future use.

The next order of business was consideration of the proposed Budget for the year 1964. Mr. Gardner presented and explained in detail the 1964 Budget as prepared by the Budget Committee. It was then unanimously agreed that the Budget as presented is hereby adopted.

It was also unanimously agreed that Tax Ordinance #52 fixing the Tax Rate for Borough purposes at eight mills, is hereby adopted.

Miss Dickson advised that the Planning Commission recommends that the name of the Borough be changed to Wawa.

Mr. Ward appointed Mr. Gardner, Mr. Kelly and Mr. Kerns, as a committee to seek a replacement for Mr. Clifford Farr as a member of Council.

Mr. Ward also appointed Mr. Smitheman to keep Council informed on the proposed school consolidation plan.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
