The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

Mayor Breneman reported complaints on trash dumped on Valleybrook Rd.

One violator was arrested and fined \$25.00

President Hobaugh presented the resignation of Mr. Robert Lundquist as a member of the Board of Adjustment, which was accepted with regrets and acknowledged. Mr. Kerns was appointed as a committee of one to recommend a replacement for Mr. Lundquist.

Mrs. John Tucker was recommended for the position of Borough Treasurer, to replace Miss Dickson. Mrs. Tucker was then duly appointed Boro. Treasurer to become effective on August 1st.

Mr. Hobaugh reported that he has been informed by Mr. Schroder that the School Board has not received official notice from Council regarding the School Building. This matter was tabled for thirty days.

Mr. Hobaugh also reported that he has been informed that the Elwyn School has abandoned the use of the Boy Scout camp on the Fritz property and that Mr. Fritz has not permitted the removal of the buildings as originally agreed. This matter was also tabled.
