The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

Mayor Breneman advised that upon further investigation of all available records no evidence was found regarding an agreement between the Borough or the Zoning Board of Adjustment and the operators of the former Camp Fritz Scout property.

Highway Committee; Mr. Kerns advised that the roads would be cleaned and signs replaced during the coming month.

Public Safety; Mr. Smitheman advised that a meeting was held with the Mayor, Borough Solicitor and Justice of Peace to discuss the problem of traffic control and school protection in the Borough. The committee recommended that crossing lines be painted on the highway at the school and additional police protection be provided, also that one Police Car speedometer be calibrated and certified for speed checking.

Unanimous approval was granted for all of these recommendations.

Mr. Arthur T. Murphy was unanimously appointed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Lundquist.
