DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

I, Fred Wood, Mayor, hereby declare a Disaster Emergency existing for the Borough of Chester Heights, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority vested by the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, P.L. 1332, November 26, 1978, as amended, 35 Pa.C.S.A Section 7501 (b), because of the potential of severe damage caused by the effects of a significant snowstorm and high winds throughout the Borough beginning on Sunday, January 31, 2021 and, because of a potential number of Chester Heights Borough residents being without electric power, services and/or heat. This declaration shall remain in effect until revoked by the Mayor under his direction, in writing, or in five (5) days, unless revoked by a majority of the Borough Council, whichever shall occur earlier.

The local emergency management plans of the Borough are hereby activated and the furnishing of aid and assistance thereunder is hereby authorized. Residents are encouraged to avoid unnecessary travel on Borough and State roads during this time.

The emergency provisions of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code relating to contracts and obligations, and the employment of personnel are hereby enabled.
