Did you know, Senior Citizens (65 years old or older) travel FREE on ALL SEPTA Transit routes (bus, trolley, trackless trolley, subway, regional rail, and Norristown High Speed Lines). In addition, for travel to stations in NJ/DE, 50% off the Weekday fare with a valid form of identification to verify age.

With the full transition of the SEPTA Key fare system, PA issued [Senior Citizen Transit ID Cards ARE NO LONGER VALID FOR TRAVEL](#) on SEPTA so we are encouraging all Senior riders to get their new SEPTA Key Senior Photo ID.

With SEPTA Key, Seniors will enjoy the travel convenience of this new self-serve system by tapping their SEPTA Key Senior ID at the farebox or turnstile Validator.
